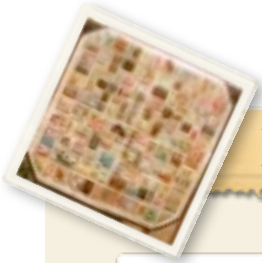

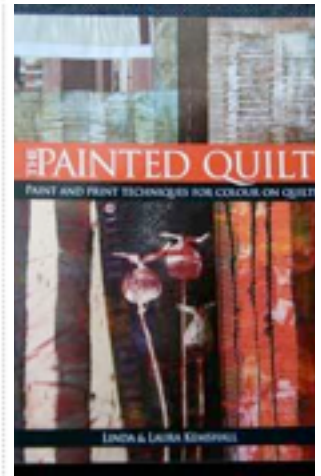

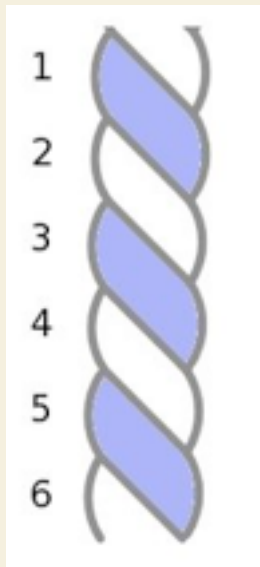


PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Thread made from two threads

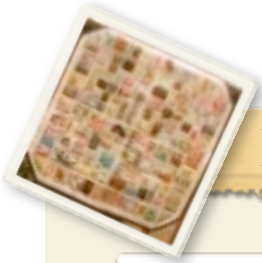


How to determine the number of twists per inch in a piece of yarn

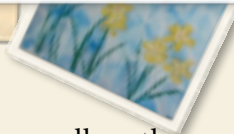

THIS MONTH OCTOBER QUILT MEETING

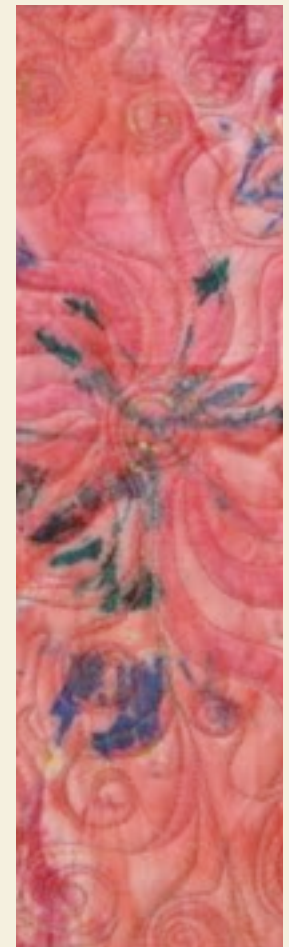
