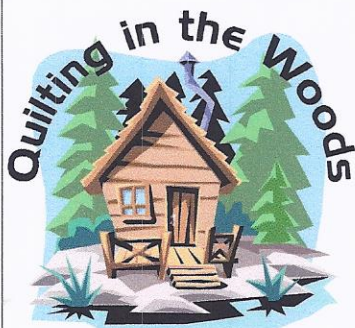

# BLOCK OF THE MONTH

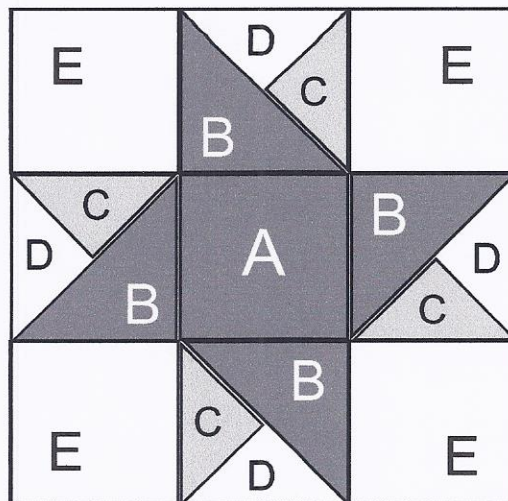
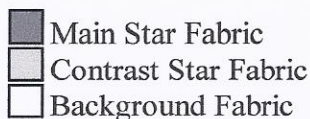
## PARTY HAT!

A funky version of the Friendship Star - have fun with this one!

Size: 9" Finished (9-1/2" unfinished) This is smaller than the previous blocks. A border will be added later to make it 12" finished.

\*Note-each piece has a letter that will refer to placement on the piecing diagram.

- A) Cut 1 - 3-1/2" square main star fabric (dark or medium value)
- B) Cut 2 - 3-7/8" squares main star fabric, cut diagonally twice
- C) Cut 1 - 4-1/4" square contrast star fabric (medium or light value), cut diagonally twice
- D) Cut 1 - 4-1/4" square background fabric, cut diagonally twice
- E) Cut 4 - 3-1/2" squares background fabric



1. Layout pieces according to the diagram.
2. Sew pieces C and D together. Press toward contrast star fabric. Repeat for each set.
3. Sew piece C/D to B. Press toward main star fabric. Repeat for each set.
4. Sew each block together as you would a Nine-Patch. Press.
