The changes I am proposing are highlighted below. I would like to have the Facebook group be members only, available only to those who are paying dues. I'm aware of a few members of the group that want to be involved even though they no longer live here. For this purpose, I'm proposing a 'remote membership' of \$15. They would have access to all handouts and programs that we are doing as a guild, but they wouldn't be eligible for any of the prizes given at meetings. Please read over the changes below and come prepared to vote at our meeting.

MEETINGS: Regular guild meetings will be held on the first Thursday of each month from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., unless otherwise designated for specific occasions such as Retreats, Holidays, etc.

MEMBERSHIP / DUES: Membership in the Heber Valley Quilters Guild renews annually, beginning in January of each year. Funds received for dues will be collected by the Treasurer, and held in the guild banking account to fund guild activities such as, but not limited to: Guest presenter fees, monthly drawing prizes, small birthday gifts for guild members, handouts, etc.

HEBER VALLEY QUILTERS MEMBERSHIP: \$25 annual dues. Entitles member to receive monthly newsletter, attend meetings and workshops. Membership is open to adults age 18 and over. Additional fees may be assessed for special events to cover costs of instructor or function. **REMOTE MEMBERSHIP:** \$15. Dues will be prorated for new members joining any time during the year.
