Come early to guild and to browse through the exhibit and see the quilts on display. The exhibit runs through January 12th.

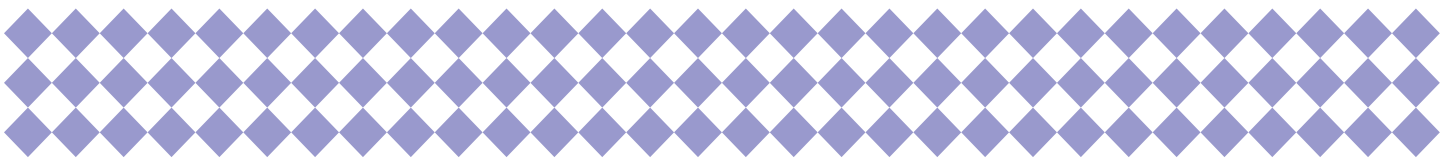

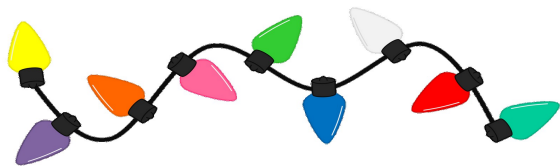
