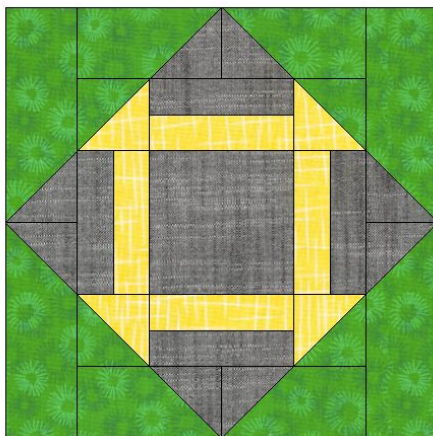


## Center Block - 6 ½" x 6 ½"



### Fabric A: Black

#### Cut:

- 1 - 2 ½" x 2 ½" square
- 1 - 1" x 10 ½" rectangle
- 8 - 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares

### Fabric B: Yellow

#### Cut:

- 2 - 2" x 2" squares
- 1 - 1" x 10 ½" rectangle

### Fabric C: Green

#### Cut:

- 2 - 2" x 2" squares
- 4 - 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles
- 4 - 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles

Use a scant ¼" when sewing.

1. Using Fabric B & C - 2" squares, mark diagonally on wrong side. Placing RST, sew ¼" on either side of marked line. Cut apart. Trim to 1 ½" square. Press open.
2. Using Fabric A & B 1" x 10 ½" strips, sew RST. Press to dark fabric. Trim into 4 - 2 ½" lengths - Pieces will be 1 ½" x 2 ½".
3. Using the HST from step 1, and the strip sets from step 2, sew into a churn dash block, following the diagram above as reference.
4. Mark a diagonal line on the back of the 1 ½" squares of fabric A. Using the rectangles from fabric C and the squares, assemble following the diagrams below. Make two of each block. Sew directly on the line, and trim ¼" away from the line. Press open.



5. Sew rectangles from step 4 together along the short sides of the snowball block making 4 sets. Using the short sets of rectangles just formed, sew to 2 sides of your churn dash block. Press open, and sew remaining strips to other sides of block.

HST = Half Square Triangle  
 RST = Right Sides Together
