

Mystery Quilt Round 2

Fabric A - Pink

10 - 4 1/2" squares

2 - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

- Fabric B Blue
 - 2 7 1/2" squares
 - 2 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ squares
 - 8 3 1/2" squares

Background Fabric

- 2 7 1/2" squares
- 6 4 ½" squares
- 8 3 1/2 x 6 1/2" rectangles


Make half square triangles (HST) from: Fabric A/Background Fabric - 6 squares - 4 ½" Trim to 3 ½" - You will have 12 finished HST




Fabric A/B - 2 squares - 5 ¹/₂"
Trim to 4 ¹/₂" - You will have 4 HSTs
Using remaining 4 ¹/₂" Fabric A squares, make split HST blocks by repeating process
Trim to 3 ¹/₂" - You will have 8 HSTs




Fabric B/Background - 2 squares - 7 ¹/₂" Trim to 6 ¹/₂" - You will have 4 finished HST



Paying attention to the direction of the squares according to the diagram, sew 2 Fabric A/Bkgd HST together and sew to top of center square



Repeat process to bottom of center square. Sew side squares together, and sew to center piece.



Sew 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B square to split HST square, paying attention to the direction according to the diagram. Sew 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to the top of unit. Sew 2 blocks together, and sew to top of center block. Repeat process for bottom of block.

Sew together two groups, and sew to the top of center blocks. Repeat for bottom of block.

For sides, sew 6 ½" HST blocks to split HST units as indicated in diagram. Sew to sides of center block.
