Our Guild Meeting will be held Friday, June 10th at 6:30 pm at the Midway Community Center.



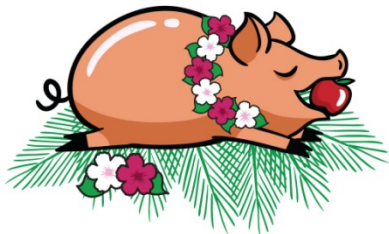
June's President's Message:
