

See below what you need to be prepared for the Prairie Point Ornament: Materials to bring for the prairie point ornament:

Sixteen 5 inch square (double folder into a triangle "prairie point" and pressed).

12 inches of satin cord or ribbon for hanger.

2 buttons to cover center of each side.

Extra long sewing needle (3 1/2 inch doll making needle works well.

30 inches of 30 weight thread.

The quilt will have some fabric, buttons, needles, and thread but you are encouraged to bring your own.

The Scandinavian star materials are also optional: Hot glue gun and silicone working mat.
