

Daffodil Block
(pattern resized from the Fat Quarter Shop, Carolina Lily)
Unfinished size: 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Fabric Requirements

Yellow 4x10
Green 8x12
White 4x8
Background (not white) 12x15

Cutting Instructions

Yellow fabric:

1 @ 3 1/2 square (A)
2 @ 2 x 6 1/2 (B)

White fabric:

8 @ 2 x 2 (C)

Green fabric:

2 @ 1 1/2 x 6 1/2 (D)
1 @ 2 square (E)
1 @ 1 x 8 (F)
2 @ 1 x 4 (bias cut, vine)

Background fabric:

1 @ 4 1/2 square (G)
1 @ 2 x 6 1/2 (H)
1 @ 2 x 5 (I)
4 @ 2 x 3 1/2 (J)
4 @ 3 1/2 square (K)
5 @ 2 square (L)

Assembly Instructions

Make flying geese (Petal Unit):

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square on one end of a Fabric J rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4 inch away from the seam. Press open.

Repeat on the opposite end.

Petal Unit should measure 2 x 3 1/2

Make 4.

Make Corner Flower:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E square.

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric E square on the bottom right corner of the Fabric A square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4 inch away from the seam. Press open.

Unit should measure $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$

Make 1.

Sew Fabric L to one end of a Petal Unit. Should measure 2×5 inches.

Sew one Petal Unit to solid yellow side of corner flower (A and E). Should measure $3\frac{1}{2} \times 5$ inches.

Sew these two units together.

Sew (I) to side of bottom and (H) to side of unit. See diagram for placement.

Corner Flower Unit should measure $6\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

Make Side Flower:

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F on the top of a Fabric B rectangle.

Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam one length of fabric. Unit should measure $3 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric K squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square on the top end of a Fabric F/B rectangle.

(Fabric K will flow off the green fabric side)

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ inch away from the seam. Press open.

Repeat on the other end of the rectangle to form Base of Side Flower.

Trim Unit to measure $3 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$. (The background fabric will need to be trimmed off)

The background fabric will not meet at the top. The stem will fit in this space.

Make 2

Sew one Fabric L to both ends of Petal Unit as diagramed.

Make 2

Assemble Side Flower Unit.

Sew Petal Unit to Base of Flower unit

Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

Make 2.

Assemble daffodil block as illustrated one row at a time.

Unit should measure

$10\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$

Make vines.

Sew scant $\frac{1}{4}$ seam lengthwise with wrong sides together.

Repeat for all three vine units.

Press flat so seam is invisible from the front.

Position long strip at the diagonal and the short strips curved to the center as illustrated.

Applique in place.

Daffodil Block should measure $10\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$
