Disappearing Pinwheel Quilts

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Supplies/Fabric Requirements:

12 Fat Quarters: 6 Dark, 6 Light
OR For a Two-Color Quilt:
1-1/2 yards each Light & Dark prints
6" x 24" Acrylic Ruler
Rotary Cutter
Mat
Quilt in a Day 9.5" Triangle Square Up Ruler (helpful tool)

Secondary Border (Optional)

Materials needed: 3/4 yard medium tone or coordinating background fabric 3/8 yard light fabric OR eight 5 1/2" squares assorted light fabrics 3/8 yard dark fabric OR eight 5 1/2" squares assorted dark fabrics

Outside Borders

3/4 yard fabric for 2 1/2" border 1 3/4 yard for 5 1/2" border



Disappearing Pinwheel Quilt Instructions

Cutting Instructions

Cut each fat quarter into 16-3/4" x 16-3/4" squares, Or cut yardage in to (6) 16-3/4" light squares and (6) 16-3/4" dark squares

Instructions

- 1. Layer one 16.75" light square and one 16.75" dark square with right sides together.
- 2. Repeat with rest of squares. (Total of 6 pairs)
- 3. Make 48 half square triangles using the Magic 8 method.

Magic 8 HST Method

- 1. Draw diagonal lines in both directions from corner to corner.
- 2. Stitch 1/4" away from each side of the diagonal lines in both directions.
- 3. Cut a vertical line from top to bottom through the center of the square.
- 4. Cut a horizontal line from side to side through the center of the square (+).
- 5. Cut diagonal lines in both directions from corner to corner (x).

Square up half square triangles to 7.75"

- 1. Square up HST's with Quilt in a Day's Triangle Square-Up Ruler or other ruler.
- 2. Press half square triangles toward the dark fabric.

Create 15" Pinwheel 4-patch

- 1. Sew half square triangles into a 15" Pinwheel 4-patch.
- 2. Make 12.

Prepare Disappearing Pinwheel Blocks

- 1. Cut pinwheel block into 3rds vertically 2.5" from right center and left center.
- 2. Cut pinwheel block into 3rds horizontally 2.5" from right center and left center.
- 3. Each square should measure 1/3rd of width and length. (5")
- 4. Rearrange block into desired Disappearing Pinwheel Block (Refer to Disappearing Pinwheel Chart).
- 5. Stitch 9-patch blocks into desired design.


Secondary Border instructions:


Cut 16 @ 5 1/2" medium background squares. Cut 14 @ 5" medium background squares Cut 8 @ 5 1/2" light fabric squares and 8 @ 5 1/2" dark fabric squares


Make 32 4 1/2" finished half square triangles.

- Pair 8 dark with 8 medium background squares with right sides together. Pair 8 light with 8 medium background squares together.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the lighter squares.
- 3. Stitch 1/4" from the marked line on both sides.
- 4. Cut on the center line between stitching lines.
- 5. Trim blocks to 5" square; press seams toward darker fabric.
