

March Quilt Block
Four Leaf Clover

Fabric Requirements

From two different green fabric cut

2 @ $3\frac{3}{4} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$

2 @ $2\frac{1}{4} \times 3\frac{3}{4}$

1 @ $1 \times 1\frac{3}{4}$

White (or background) cut

4 @ $2\frac{1}{4}$ square

8 @ $1\frac{1}{4}$ square

6 @ $1\frac{3}{4}$ square

2 @ $1\frac{1}{4} \times 1\frac{3}{4}$

Assembly Instructions

First make the stem. Sew one $1 \times 1\frac{3}{4}$ green strip to one $1\frac{1}{4} \times 1\frac{3}{4}$ white strip. Repeat for the second green strip. To construct the clover, use your favorite stitch and flip method. Draw a diagonal line on all the white squares except 4 @ $2\frac{1}{4}$ squares. Draw a diagonal line on the stem squares, but make sure to alternate the direction to the long green segments are facing one another. See diagram.

Layout the quilt block as shown. First, sew all white squares and stem squares on the diagonal line, press to the green fabric and trim to $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from seam. Next, sew pieces together in rows. Press seams open. Sew rows together to form block.
