

HVQ Halloween Ghost  
Block of the Month by Lara Wilson


Fabric requirements:

Ghost color (light)

Segment	# to cut	size in inches
B	1	5 1/2 x 2 1/2
C	2	2 1/2 x 1 1/2
D & H	3	1 1/2 x 1 1/2
E	2	2 1/2 x 2
F	1	1 1/2 x 1 1/4
G	1	5 1/2 x 3 1/2
I	1	3 x 8

Background color (dark)

A	1	3 x 7
K	2	1 3/4 x 10 1/2
L	1	3 x 1 1/2
M	1	3 x 3
N	1	2 1/2 x 2 1/2
O	1	1 1/2 x 1 1/4
P & Q	5	1 1/2 x 1 1/2



Cut all pieces and arrange as illustrated before sewing. Sew all seams a scant 1/4 inch.

Draw diagonal line on square pieces H, M, N, P & Q. First, create multi-piece segments using flip and turn method.

- Sew on line Q squares to upper corners of B. Flip, trim 1/4 inch from sew line, press to dark.
- Sew on line H squares to lower corners of L. Flip, trim 1/4 inch from sew line, press to dark.
- Sew on line N and M squares to lower corners of I. Flip, trim 1/4 inch from sew line, press to dark.
- Sew on line P squares to right corner of C. Flip, trim 1/4 inch from sew line, press to dark.
- Sew F to O along the length of fabric, unit will measure 1 1/2 x 2.

Assemble "head" of ghost in rows, trim to measure 5 1/2 x 8.

Assemble top of "tail," segment A to L, trim to measure 3 x 8.

Sew "head" to "tail unit, to create "top" of ghost, trim to measure 8 x 8.

Sew "bottom" of ghost to "top" of ghost, trim to measure 8 x 10 1/2.

Sew K to either side of ghost, trim to 10 1/2 x 10 1/2.
