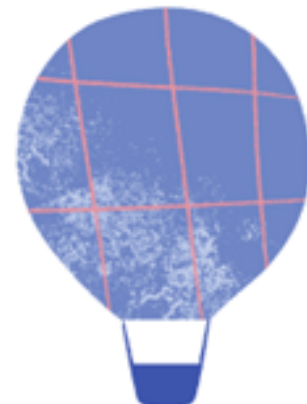
Quilt Show at the Library

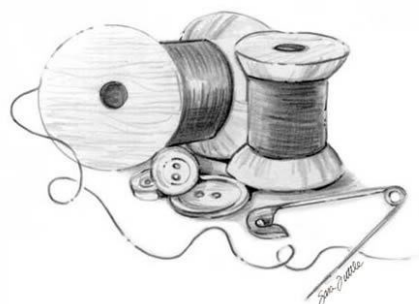
