Right now we need the following:

Quilts for KIDS: (QFK)

- * Kids 100% fabric (Novelty prints and solids)
- * Any completed QFK kits

Wheelchair Quilts:

* Completed "Chippewa" kits

Fidget Items:

- * 5" squares of fusible interfacing (Pellon's Featherweight 911FF or Midweight 931TD) for the fidget quilts.
- * 19" x 24" rectangular pieces of batting for the fidget quilts (can be sewn together)
- * Small plastic or metal rings
- Applique/Wool patches

More QFK Kits and Wheelchair Kits to sew will be available at the meeting, along with some Wheelchair quilts that need to be "enveloped" (three layers—top, batting, backing--

We are in the 4th month of 2023. How are you temperature quilts coming along? Be sure and share at guild meeting.


