So that we can keep the Senior Center going with tying our Wheelchair Quilts, I will have quilt kits available for you to complete at the retreat or take home.

For the Fidget Quits, we still need the following two items, so bring these to the retreat, please:

- 5" squares of <u>fusible interfacing</u> (Pellon's Featherweight 911FF or Midweight 931TD) for the Fidget quilts.
- 19" x 24" <u>rectangular pieces of batting</u> (can be sewn together)
