- ◆ Quilt for Kids' quilt tops with backings

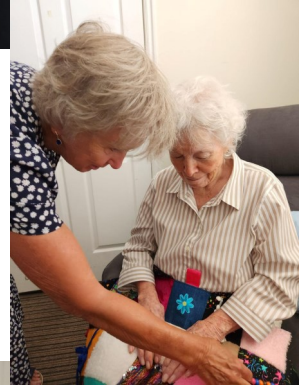
Also bring any uncompleted Fidget Quilt kits, along with any kids' fabric you would like to donate QFK.

We are now in the **8th** month of 2023! With July's heat, there should be some interesting color changes happening in your temperature masterpieces.

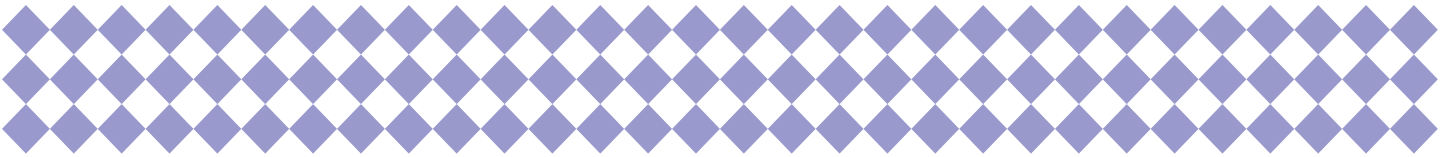

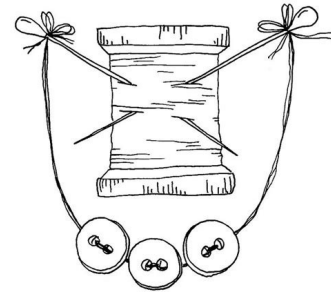
