## Mitered Corners

- 1. Measure the quilt sides, and the top and bottom.
- 2. For each side add the width of the border times two.
- 3. Example If a quilt side is 40" and your border is 4"

$$40" + 2X4 = 48"$$
 Cut border  $48"$ 

- 4. Find the middle of a quilt side and put a pin. Find the middle of the border and put a pin. Match the pins and continue pinning the side.
- 5. Sew the border to a side beginning and ending ¼" away from the ends.
- 6. Do the same on all sides.
- 7. Fold quilt at corner diagonally (45\*) right sides together. Line up borders. This is easily done on the ironing board and you can iron the fold.
- 8. With a 6" X 24" ruler draw a diagonal line on the border.
- 9. Sew on drawn line.
- 10. Trim to ¼" and press open
- 11. Repeat on all corners.

PS If you are going to use multiple borders sew them together before putting on quilt.
