

Mitered Corners

1. Measure the quilt sides, and the top and bottom.
2. For each side add the width of the border times two.
3. Example - If a quilt side is 40" and your border is 4"
 $40" + 2 \times 4 = 48"$ Cut border 48"
4. Find the middle of a quilt side and put a pin. Find the middle of the border and put a pin. Match the pins and continue pinning the side.
5. Sew the border to a side beginning and ending $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the ends.
6. Do the same on all sides.
7. Fold quilt at corner diagonally (45^*) right sides together. Line up borders. This is easily done on the ironing board and you can iron the fold.
8. With a 6" X 24" ruler draw a diagonal line on the border.
9. Sew on drawn line.
10. Trim to $\frac{1}{4}"$ and press open
11. Repeat on all corners.

PS If you are going to use multiple borders sew them together before putting on quilt.
