2023 Local Charity Quilts

HVQ By-Laws' Mission Statement:

To provide a forum for local quilters of every interest level to meet together on a monthly basis to promote the art of quilt making, in order to:

- * Learn new quilting techniques,
- * Teach quilting and related skills to one another,
- * Show and Tell ("Sew & Tell") current projects and ideas,
- * Provide encouragement and support for each other,
- * **Provide opportunities for charity service to our community.**

This year, we will be focusing on **two local community groups**:

1. **KIDS:** (work on Quilts for Kids' kits on an individual basis in your own home)
 - a. **Donating** fabrics
 - i. 100% cotton novelty prints and solids for quilt tops, including pre-cuts
 - ii. 1.5 yards x WOF backing fabrics
 - b. **Piecing** quilt tops, according to a few selected simple quilt kit patterns
 - c. **Joining** batting pieces
 - d. **Sandwiching** pieced tops with batting and backing fabrics for quilting
 - e. **Quilting** on domestic or long-arm machines
 - f. **Binding** quilts by machine
 - g. **Funding** purchased batting and/or backing fabrics
2. **SENIORS:** (work on quilts for local senior citizens in a guild group format)
 - a. **Local Senior Living Communities:**
 - i. Spring Gardens Senior Living Community (fidget quilts & wall hanging)
 - ii. Rocky Mountain Care (10 fidget quilts/activity mats)*
 - iii. Heber Valley Assisted Living (7 wheelchair quilts & 7 lap quilts)
 - b. **Wasatch County Senior Center:**
 - i. Set up a revolving quilt sandwich in a quilt frame in the lounge/TV area for anyone to help tie together with yarn
 - ii. Include seniors to HVQ's Saturday "Sew Day" at the Senior Center scheduled for June 17, 2023
 - iii. (Both of the above two activities will benefit the three local senior living communities)

- *PLEASE start searching through your stash for items to donate for the fidget quilts:
- a. Charm packs (5" squares), including textured squares, & Minky backing fabric
 - b. Zippers, buttons, fringe, wooden beads, sew-on Velcro, snaps, yarn, lace, ribbon, elastic, pom-poms, pockets, ties, shoelaces, tassels, buckles, plastic rings, rick-rack, buckles, textured fabrics & trims, etc.
 - c. Everything must be washable! PLEASE BRING TO THE NEXT MEETING!
