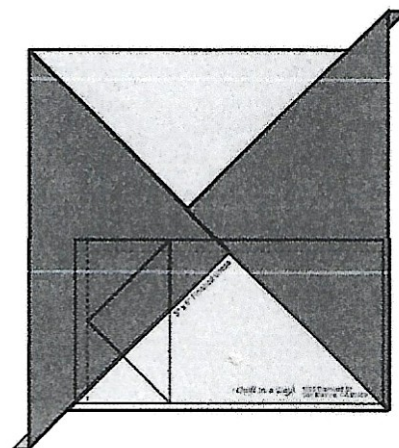
## Making Eight Star Points for 12" Block

### Making Four Large Star Points

1. Place  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Background square right sides together and centered on 9" Star Point square.

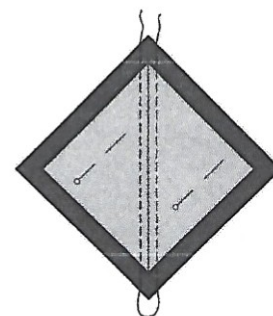


2. Follow instructions for making Star Points on pages 24-27. Trim patches with Small Geese ruler, squaring to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Finished size is 3" x 6".

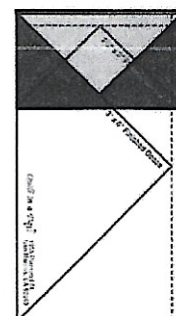


### Making Four Small Star Points

1. Place  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Background square right sides together and centered on 6" Star Point square.



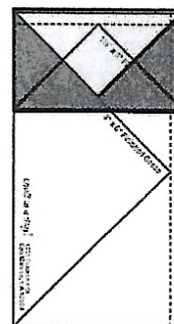
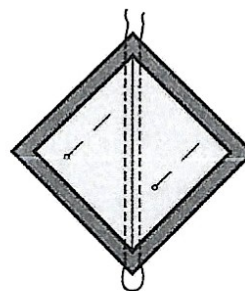
2. Follow instructions for making Star Points on pages 24-27. Trim patches with Small Geese ruler, squaring to 2" x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Finished size is  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3".
3. Turn to page 132.



# Making Eight Star Points for 6" Block

## Making Four Large Star Points

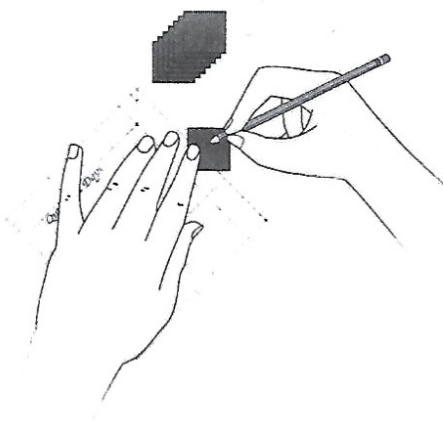
1. Place 4½" Background square right sides together and centered on 6" Star Point square.
2. Follow instructions for making Star Points on pages 24-27. Trim patches with Small Geese ruler, squaring to 2" x 3½". Finished size is 1½" x 3".



## Making Four Small Star Points

1. Turn eight 1¼" squares wrong side up. Draw diagonal line.

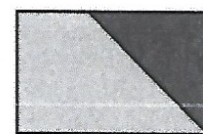
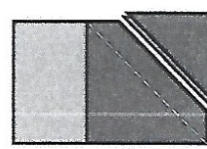
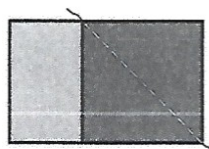
Optional: If available, use Angler in place of drawing diagonal lines.



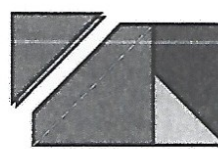
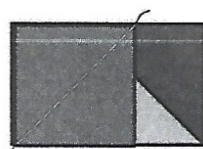
2. Place one square wrong sides together on 1¼" x 2" Background.



3. Sew on drawn line and trim seam to ¼". Press seam toward Star Points.



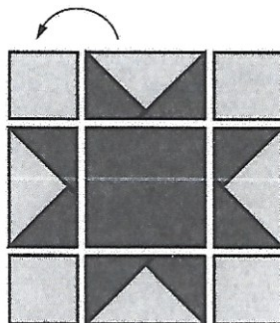
4. Repeat process with remaining Star Points.





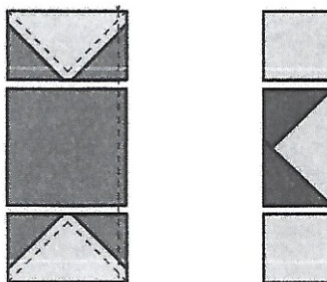
# Making Small Star

1. Lay out the Center square, Corner squares and Points.

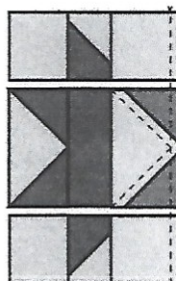


12" Block	Star Points	(4) 2" x 3½"
	Corner Squares	(4) 2" squares
	Center Square	(1) 3½" square
6" Block	Star Points	(4) 1¼" x 2"
	Corner Squares	(4) 1¼" squares
	Center Square	(1) 2" square

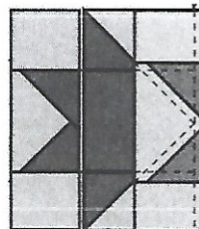
2. Flip middle row to left. Assembly-line sew vertical row.



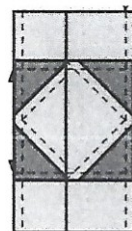
3. Open and add right row.



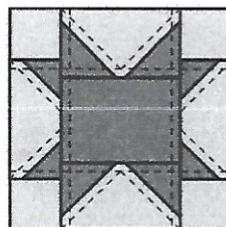
4. Sew first horizontal row, pressing seams toward Star Center, and away from the Star Points.



5. Sew second horizontal row, repeating seams. Set seams, open, and press.



6. Check from wrong side. Horizontal seams should be pressed away from center. Press. Measure your block.



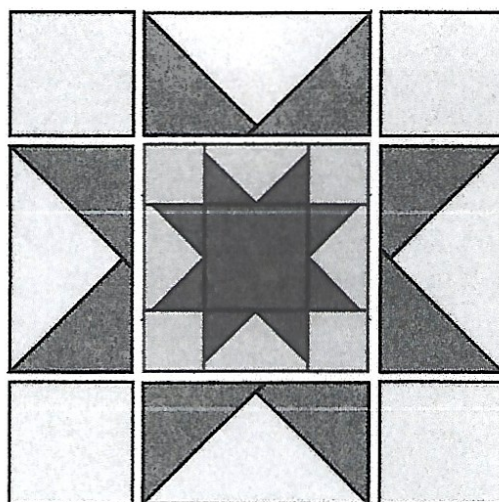

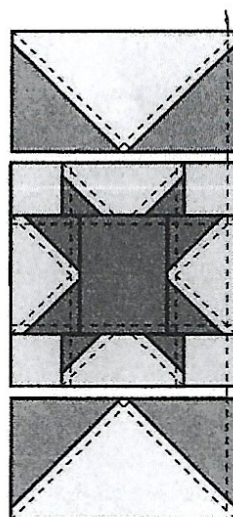
# Finishing North Star

1. Lay out Small Star with Corners and Star Points. Turn Small Star with last seams in horizontal position.

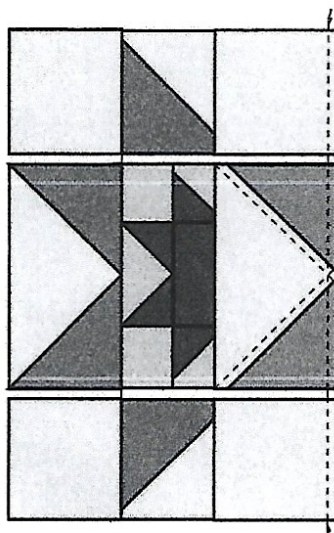
12" Block	Star	(1) 6½" square
	Corner Squares	(4) 3½" squares
	Star Points	(4) 3½" x 6½"
6" Block	Star	(1) 3½" square
	Corner Squares	(4) 2" squares
	Star Points	(4) 2" x 3½"



2. Flip middle row to left. Check horizontal seams on Star. Assembly-line sew all vertical seams.

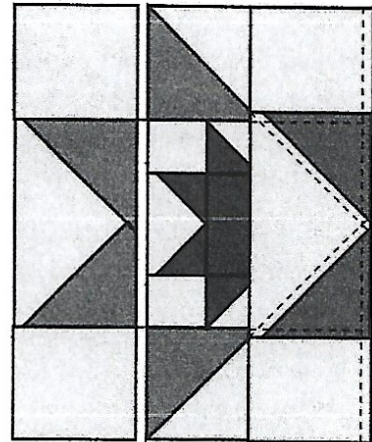


3. Open and add right row.

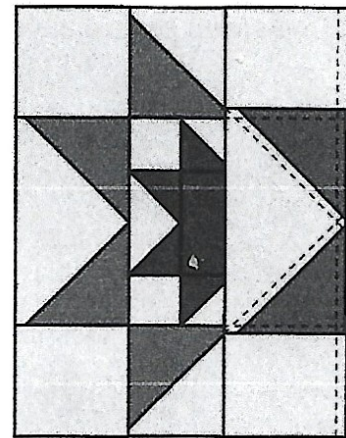




4. Sew first horizontal row, pressing seams toward Star, and away from Star Points.



5. Sew second horizontal row, repeating seams. Set seams, open, and press.



6. Check from wrong side. Horizontal seams should be pressed away from center.
