Making Your Story Label


- 1. Tear out page 159.
- Load one sheet of Colorfast Printer Fabric™
 (June Tailor product number JT900) into
 paper tray so copying occurs on fabric side
 of sheet.
- 3. Place story page into copier and photo copy. If you are making the label for 6" block quilt, reduce size by (.66).
- 4. Remove backing from fabric. Allow ink to dry.

Making a Block for the Front of Your Quilt

- 1. Square up printed label fabric.
- 2. 12" Block: Add a 2½" border on all four sides. Square to 12½".
- 3. 6" Block: Square to 61/2".
- 4. Use as sixteenth block in your quilt.



Making a Label for the Back of Your Quilt

- 1. Sew a hem around all four sides of label.
- 2. Hand-sew to back of quilt.



Colorfast Printer Fabric™ can be washed by hand or machine in cold water. If machine washing, use gentle cycle. Remove promptly. If soiled, add liquid fabric softener to cold water wash. Lay flat to dry.
