

Quick & Pretty 3-D Applique'

- 1) Follow manufacturers' instructions apply fusible web to the *wrong* side of fabric. Use a hot, dry iron. Hold in place for about 3 seconds per section, overlapping iron until the fusible is adhered to the fabric. Allow to cool, then peel off paper backing.
- 2) PRESS two fused sides together.
- 3) CUT out shapes with sharp scissors or die cutting machine.
- 4) STITCH to apply where desired.



For added dimension, PRESS to reheat shapes, then roll or form as desired, holding in place until cool to keep the shape.

Chenille

USE SOLID COLOR DYED FABRIC

- 1) FOLD a square diagonally in half.
- 2) STITCH parallel rows, beginning about 1/2-inch from the folded edge. Continue stitching rows 1/2-inch apart until the entire triangle is stitched.
- 3) CUT using rotary blade and ruler, half way between each stitched line. CUT ends square.
- 4) Use to outline applique or quilt motifs, or for binding. BACK-STITCH at beginnings and endings; overlap 1/4" to join strips.
- 5) BRUSH out with a stiff-bristled brush, or throw project in the wash to blossom the chenille.
