background fabric, and 6 colorful strips of fabric
(preferably small or no pattern) at least 2 inches by
WOF

Ironing boards and cutting mats will be provided.

These blocks will have a place in the 15th Anniversary
HVQG art quilt (block of the month).

Remember to bring \$30 for Retreat (May 2 & 3 in
Charleston) before the cost goes to \$35 (weekend of
April 4th) so the committee can finish their
preparations. You will be glad you came, and it
wouldn't be the same without you!

If you have signed up with Trish to bring something
for the refreshment table, this is just a 'happy'
reminder.

Thanks to all of you who have already brought such
wonderful things to share with the guild. We have such
an amazing group in the Heber Guild!

If you haven't already turned in your "Queen
