

HVQ Block 4: Dutchman's Puzzle

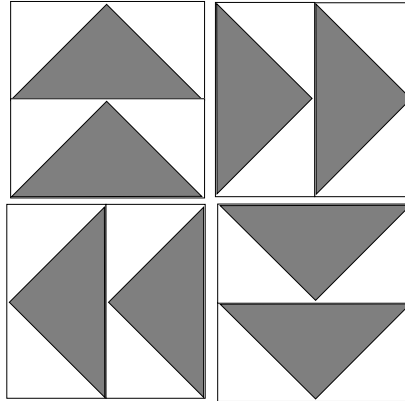
6" Block (6-1/2" unfinished):

Dark prints:

Cut (2) 4-1/4" squares

Light prints:

Cut (8) 2-3/8" squares



12" Block (12-1/2" unfinished):

Dark Prints:

Cut (2) 7-1/4" squares

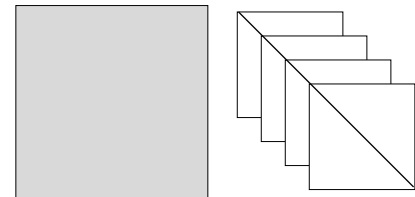
Light prints:

Cut (8) 3-7/8" squares

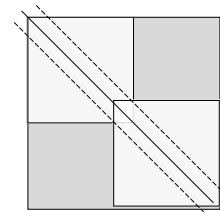
INSTRUCTIONS

1) DRAW a diagonal line on the wrong side of each small square.

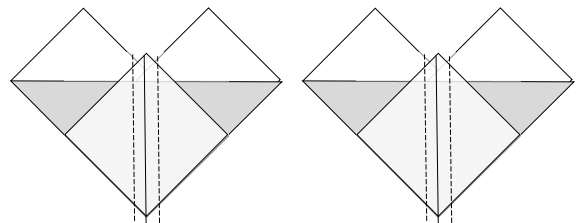
2) With right sides together, LAYER two small squares on opposite corners of the large squares and STITCH on both sides of the drawn lines, 1/4" from the line.



3) CUT on the drawn line and PRESS small triangles away from larger triangle.



4) LAYER remaining small squares on both units with right sides together, then STITCH 1/4" from the drawn line on both sides.



5) CUT on the drawn line. Press toward small triangles. Trim to size. (For 6" block, trim to 3-1/2" x 2". For 12" block, trim units to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2". Yield: 4 Flying Geese.

6) Repeat to make a second set of Flying Geese. Stitch together in pairs and arrange as diagrammed above with the "geese" flying in different directions. Stitch sets together, then stitch rows together.
