

# Let's talk Turkey

19X61

## Supplies:

½ yard cream fabric  
15 Fat Quarters or scraps  
¼ yard Outer border Fabric  
1/3 yard binding

\*WOF= width of fabric \*¼" seam allowance used unless stated

## Cutting:

Cut (2) 2 ½ X 18 strips from each fat quarter

Sub Cut (2) 2 ½ X 5 piece from each color

Cut the remainder strips pieces into 2 ½ X 2 ½ squares.

Need a total of 84 squares

Cream cut (2) 14 ½ X 14 ½ squares

Cut (2) 1 ½ X WOF

Sub Cut from each strip (1) 1 ½ X 12 ½ and (1) 1 ½ X 30 ½

Outer border fabric Cut (4) 2X WOF

Sub Cut (2) 2 X 14 ½ and Cut (2) 2X 61 ½

Binding fabric Cut (4) 2 ½ X WOF strips

Cut out and prep the applique' pieces for the turkeys using which ever method you would like.

Use the remainder of the fat quarters to make your back.

## Sewing:

Sew the 2 ½ X 2 ½ squares into 14 rows of 6.

Sew the 1 ½ X 12 ½ cream strip to the ends of the pieced blocks. Press

Sew the 1 ½ X 30 ½ cream strip to each side of the patch work section. Press

Make the Dresden plate feathers by folding the feather piece in half-length wise



with right sides together.

Sew across the wider end. Clip the ends and turn right side out. Press

Sew the feathers together into groups of 15.

Center the feathers in the middle of the  $14\frac{1}{2} \times 14\frac{1}{2}$  cream squares. Stitch down.

Add the other turkey pieces and applique' them on.

Once turkey blocks are done, sew them onto each end of the patch block section.

Sew the  $2 \times 14\frac{1}{2}$  outer border piece onto each end. Press

Sew the  $2 \times 61\frac{1}{2}$  strips onto sides of the runner.

Quilt as you like and enjoy!
