Dignity Bags

These bags will be used for patients who have had mastectomies and have a drain. Some patients have to go home with the drains, and these bags can make the drains more discreet and portable. It will also support the drains.

Supplies:

Fabric-12 by 25 inches. Please use nice, pretty, cotton fabric.

47 inch Strap-either make your own out of matching fabric or use matching webbing. If you make your own, add a little batting to help keep it strong. If you make your own, the strap is softer.

Matching thread.

Scissors or rotary cutter

To Assemble:

Hem the top of the fabric on the two short sides, about ½ inch. Fold the fabric right sides together in half, stitch the 2 sides that are not hemmed. Turn right side out. Attach the strap on the inside of the bag with a square to give the handle some support.
