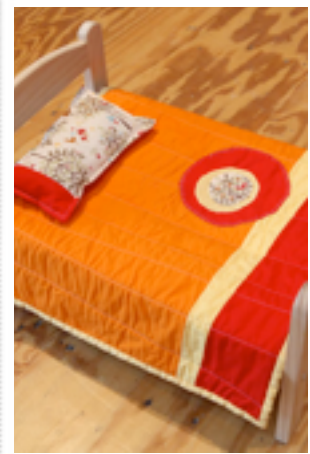

OUR MEETING THIS MONTH

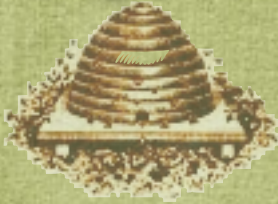

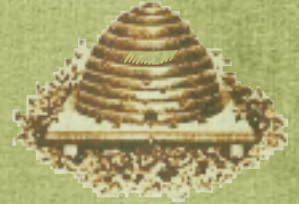

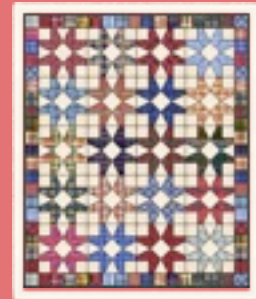
