

## SEW MUCH FUN! HVQ 2015 Row Quilt

Block #3 - Sew Tulips (Wall Hanging requirements in parentheses)

These blocks are Paper-pieced.

Yardage Suggestions:

- 4 Fat eighths in 4 different prints for tulip petals
- 1 fat eighth yellow for tulip centers
- 2 fat quarters in 2 different greens for leaves
- 3/4 yard background (1/2 yard for wall hanging)

For each tulip you will need:

- 1 6" (4-1/2") square for tulip petals
- 1 3 1/2" (2-1/2") square for tulip center
- 1 7" (5") square for tulip leaves
- 1 10" (8-1/2") square background

Download copies of the paper-piecing patterns at www.hebervalleyquilters.com/members-only.php. Copy as needed to make six of Tulip.1, six Tulip.2 and twelve Tulip Leaves.

For a dimensional center, position background piece A-1 in place, then fold a yellow square into quarters and adhere in place with a glue stick before adding colored petals. Repeat for each tulip. When you have completed 12 tulip units and 12 leaf units, stitch into a row, alternating Tulip.1 and Tulip.2 for Row #3.
