

### Tips, Tricks & Tools

While at a hand quilting class I had a tip on how to stop your thread from coming off the spool when were not using it. Here are all the wonderful tips that we all came up with:


Plastic tubing cut lengthwise will slip over and hug the end of your thread.

Rubber Bands

Glad *Press 'n' Seal* will wrap those ends up tight (found in the grocery store).

To prepare batting for a quilt, place it unfolded in the dryer with a wet washcloth till it is warm, (about 15 minutes). This technique will get rid of the fold creases and shrink any cotton fibers in it. Happy quilting,
